From September 20 to October 9, our Centre facilitated 4 workshops in local venues, teaching people some skills, connecting local residents to businesses and around some seriously good food.

Sessions included working with the Turkish Kitchen to learn about different Middle Eastern breads, a workshop with Modus for a very hands-on experience with chef Wade, learning how to pickle zucchinis to make a killer Reuben, working with Gino at the Vic Park Larder on the delicate process of making gnocchi and working with Maureen and her team at Bespoke making curries.
